Chief's Notes

Butner Public Safety will be hosting a DWI Checkpoint here in June. The BAT mobile will be here to assist. The BAT mobile units are state-of-the-art, purpose-built vehicles that serve as DWI processing centers. The BAT mobile is furnished with breath alcohol testing instruments, a magistrate's office, fingerprinting equipment, and multiple workstations. BPS has requested this due to the increased incidents involving impaired drivers.

The two new patrol cars have arrived and are having everything installed. There is not an estimated time of delivery for the 3rd approved patrol unit and it may be not delivered until after July.

BPS has been interviewing applicants over the past two weeks to hopefully fill the vacant spot and fill an open position that may be coming up due to a retirement in August.
