



## **Butner Public Safety is accepting applications for Volunteer Firefighters.**

### **Criteria for Employment:**

- Must be at least 18 years of age
- Must be a U.S. citizen or be eligible to work in the United States
- Must be a high school graduate (or equivalent)
- Must live inside the Butner Public Safety Fire District
- Must possess a valid North Carolina driver's license
- Must not have pled guilty to, entered a plea of no contest, or have been convicted of any misdemeanor within the past three years or any felony, regardless of time span.

### **The Application Process:**

Submit the following items to Butner Public Safety located at 611 Central Ave. (All items must be completed and submitted in order to be considered for membership)

- Town of Butner Application
- Authority to Release Information (Must be notarized when submitted)
- Liability Release (Must be notarized when submitted)
- Copy of North Carolina driver's license
- Copy of any fire service certifications

### **Benefits for Active Members:**

All active volunteer members of Butner Public Safety will receive the following:

- Paid membership to the North Carolina State Firemen's Association, membership provides:
  - Insurance
    - Accident and Sickness Policy
    - Accidental Death and Dismemberment
    - Additional insurance is available to be purchased which include Fraternal Insurance, MetLife Insurance, Aflac, and discounts for several other programs.
  - Educational scholarships for the member and their family
  - NCSFA members are eligible to receive a debit card with the Local Government Federal Credit Union.
  - Members of the NCSFA can receive a discount on AT&T services and devices.
  - And more.....
- Paid contributions to the Firemen's and Rescue Squad Workers' Pension Fund
  - The present Pension Fund benefit is \$170 per month, assuming 20 years of creditable service and the attainment of age 55.
- All necessary equipment is provided with no cost to the member, the equipment includes:
  - A complete set of structural firefighting protective gear (Helmet, hood, coat, pants, suspenders, boots gloves and eye protection)
  - Fire pager and charger
  - "Duty uniform" (2 BPS firefighter t-shirts and 1 pair of navy blue pants)
- All members qualify for "fee exempt" training for all fire service related classes through a local community college.
