PLANNING

The Town has seen an increase in the number of applications for new residential developments.

- Meadows at Fleming Farm, currently under construction and located at the corner of East Lyon Station Road & Shining Water Lane. 43 single-family homes developed by Cimarron Homes.
- Fleming Farm, adjacent to Meadows at Fleming Farm between Gate Two Road and US Hwy 15. 342 single-family homes and townhome units, developer Cimarron Homes.
- Applewood Townes East & West, located on Joe
 Peed Road. 106 townhome units.
- East Lyon Station PUD, near new Creedmoor Fuel site on East Lyon Station Road. 102 single-family homes with a commercial component.

Other approvals include:

- Corner of Central Avenue and West C Street, also known as the location of the Old Exxon. Rezoned from Central Business (CB) to Central Avenue -Mixed-Use District (CX), a Butner Gateway Overlay District. Proposed: American Hero & mixed-use development. No plans have been submitted.
- Solar Farm, on other side of railroad tracks off Honeybee Lane off West B Street.
